Sub.: Formation of Faculty/ School Level Anti-ragging committee and squads.

Ref: Directives of the Supreme Court of India dated May 16, 2007 in SLP No. (s) 24295 of 2006. University of Kerala Vs Council, Principals', Colleges, Kerala & Ors with SLP(C) No. 24296-99/2004 & W.P. (Crl) No. 173/2006 and SLP (C) No. 14356/2005) and Civil Appeal no. 887 of 887 of 2009 dated May 8, 2009.

It is commendable that the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India took the menace of ragging in educational institutions seriously and constituted a committee headed by Dr. R.K. Raghavan, former Director of CBI, to address the issue. The committee conducted a detailed study on various factors contributing to ragging and collected public opinion to better understand the problem.

Based on the committee's findings and recommendations, the Supreme Court issued several directives to all educational institutes to effectively curb ragging. These directives are aimed at holding academic institutions accountable for preventing ragging, ensuring suitable punishments for those involved in ragging incidents, and creating a safe and conducive learning environment for students. Here is a summary of the approved recommendations:

I. Factors Enlisted by the Committee:

- Academic institutions have the primary responsibility to curb ragging.
- Ragging adversely affects the standards of higher education.
- Incentives should be given to institutions that effectively curb ragging, and there should be disincentives for failure to do so.
- Enrolment in academic pursuits or campus life should not protect any adult citizen from the penal provisions of the law.
- Ragging should be seen as a failure to instill human values from an early stage.
- Behavioral patterns among students, particularly potential 'raggers,' need to be identified.
- Measures against ragging must be deterrent enough to prevent its recurrence.
- Coordinated action is required at various levels of the education system and government to make the efforts against ragging effective.
- Media and Civil Society should be involved in addressing the issue.

II. Approved Recommendations by the Supreme Court:

- Punishments for ragging incidents should be exemplary and harsh to act as a deterrent.
- In any ragging incident where the victim or their parent/guardian or the Head of Institution is dissatisfied with the institutional action, a First Information Report (FIR) must be filed with the local police by the institutional authorities. Failure or delay in filing the FIR would be considered culpable negligence on the part of the institution.

- Educational institutions must clearly state in their admission prospectus that admission may be refused or the student may be expelled if found involved in ragging.
- The authorities and functionaries of educational institutions are collectively responsible for preventing ragging, and their role will be scrutinized. Failure to take effective measures against ragging may result in actions such as denial of government grants or assistance.
- Anti-ragging committees and squads must be formed by the institutions to ensure the implementation of the committee's recommendations.
- The committee constituted by the Supreme Court will continue to monitor the functioning of the anti-ragging committees and squads and the implementation of the approved recommendations.
- By implementing these directives and recommendations, educational institutions can create a safer and more respectful environment for their students and effectively curb the menace of ragging.
