## **OUTLINE OF THE CONFERENCE**

- 1) Department of Science and Technology, Government of India organized the National Conference on “**IPR and Role of States**” on 28 July 2017 at Hotel Clarks Amer, Jaipur.
- 2) In the Inaugural session, **Prof. S. K. Jain**, IIT Delhi, was the special guest and he highlighted the importance of IPR and its role in the state in his address. **Shri Sandeep Verma**, PS, S & T, Govt. of Raj. Presided over the session. He was previously associated with Ministry of Defence. He explained the audience that when GoI provide funds to an organization than the ownership of IPR remains with the institution and they can commercialize it. Government only keeps the licensing. **Shri. O. P. Gupta**, CGPDTM, Mumbai, GoI was the chief guest and he delivered the keynote address. In his address he emphasized on how Rajasthan can get the best out of National IPR (Intellectual Property Rights) Policy 2016. He also highlighted that the key issue with

IPR policy is the ownership of the rights. He explained the three important areas, i.e., awareness of IPR Policy, Commercialization of IPR and its enforcement. The inaugural session ended with a vote of thanks by **Dr. Manu Sikarwar**, Project Director, DST (Dept. of Science and Technology), GoI.

- 3) **Four technical sessions** were held, which included IPR policy 2016 and role of states, Start-up's, Innovation, IP issues, Geographical Indications and Agriculture and IP issues
- 4) **Shri B. K. Sahu**, Deputy Manager, IPR, NRDC, DSIR GoI stated the role of NRDC (National research development corporation) in IP promotion and technology transfer. NRDC bridges the gap between R & D and Industry. It is the largest technology transfer organization in India. He also said that only patent is not important, we must create a product which is saleable.
- 5) **Shri Yashwant Panwar**, Sr. Scientist, TIFAC DST, GoI highlighted the key areas like, creative India, innovative India, make in India, digital India, smart cities and skilled India. He also specified and focused on few key objectives, i.e., IP awareness: outreach and promotion, generation of IPRs, legal and legislative framework, administrative issues and generation of IPRs and role of DST.
- 6) **Shri Pawan Pandey**, Deputy Registrar, Trade Mark, CGPDTM, Ahemdabad emphasized on protecting GI in India.
