REPORT ON INDUSTRIAL TRIP

An Industrial trip to Neemrana, Delhi and Agra for 40 students of MBA 1st semester of Poornima University from 28th to 30th August, 2018, was organized under the guidance of Ms. Arpita Mehta and Dr. Yaduveer Yadav.

The students visited companies like Parle, Havells, Q.H Talbros and Taj manufacturing house, where they learnt about the manufacturing processes, different trading processes, raw material inflows and outflows, internship process, working procedure, HR process etc. All these companies were engaged in different manufacturing activities but various TQM and TPM practices followed were similar like 3Rs, 3Ms, etc.

The students also visited the monuments in different cities that are India Gate, Iskcon Temple, Lotus Temple, Akshardham, Taj Mahal, Agra Fort where they learnt about the history of the monuments, their existence why they were made and architectural structure. These places were full of ancient INDIA knowledge which students understood after visiting the monuments.

And in the last students visited Keoladeo National Park, Bharatpur where they were close to nature and learnt about the different types of migrating birds, local migrating birds and resident birds. The names of some migrating birds about which they learnt and saw were – EGYPTIAN VULTURE , SNAKE BIRD , PAINTED STORK , PARAKEET , ASIAN CUCKOO.
